Andrew Sewell MUSIC DIRECTOR, WCO

Andrew Sewell enters his 26th season as Music Director for the Wisconsin Chamber Orchestra, and 9th season with the San Luis Obispo Symphony on California's central coast. A conductor in demand, he has successfully built the

Wisconsin Chamber Orchestra into a regional and nationally known ensemble. In California, he has inspired the central

coast community with exhilarating performances at

CalPoly's Performing Arts Center in San Luis Obispo.

During his tenure with the Wisconsin Chamber Orchestra, Maestro Sewell has raised the orchestra to new artistic heights, expanded the repertoire, and provided new experiences for the audiences through innovative and adventuresome programming. In 2023 the WCO embarked on a five-year recording project, Musical Landscapes in Color, recording living Black composers and composers of color. Two albums, Harmony in Black, and Convergence, have been released in 2024 and 2025. The third album, Endeavor, will be released in 2026.

A native of New Zealand, Maestro Sewell received his music training on the violin, piano, and cornet, and began conducting at age 16. Six years later, he made his professional opera debut with the Mercury Opera and the Auckland Philharmonia Orchestra. Winning the Australian Guarantee Corporation's Young Achiever Award allowed him to further his studies abroad. Sewell holds a Master of Music degree with Honors in Conducting from the University of Michigan.

In 2025, he was awarded the Distinguished Achievement Award by Destination Madison, for his 25 years service as Music Director of the Wisconsin Chamber Orchestra. In 2017, he was awarded the Service to Music Award from the Association of Wisconsin Symphony Orchestras, and in 2013, the Rabin Youth Arts Award for Individual Achievement, by the Wisconsin Youth Symphony Orchestra, for his services to youth and education. He and his wife, Mary, live in Madison, WI.







No other arts organization in Wisconsin performs free for more people each year.

Founded in 1960, the orchestra is built on a foundation of quality musicianship with top-tier musicians. As a smaller ensemble, we're able to showcase music at an intimate level, providing attendees with a unique experience. Under the direction of Maestro Andrew Sewell, we make classical music accessible to our community from concert halls to Madison's Capitol Square, reaching over 250,000 music lovers annually.

We are driven in our mission to strengthen communities through innovative, high-quality artistic experiences that entertain, inspire, and unite diverse audiences. And we're passionate about creating a sustainable future through our strategic plan.

Our core artistic programs include the four-decade tradition of Concerts on the Square®, the Masterworks Series at the Overture Center for the Arts, annual performances of Handel's Messiah, educational programming and concerts for families and children that serve nearly 2000 youth each year and performing with local arts groups like Madison Ballet. In 2023, the WCO launched the Composer Collective series with a five-year, five-album project titled Musical Landscapes in Color with the goal of expanding the orchestral canon to include new works by living composers of color.

About Mr. Chair

Joyful. Fearless. Unpredictable.

Mr. Chair is an innovative piano trio composed of Jason Kutz (piano), Ben Ferris (bass), and Mike Koszewski (drums). Based in Madison, the trio collaborates with singers, dancers, orchestras, string ensembles, poets and visual artists to pioneer exciting and distinct projects, showcasing their versatile style and interests in improvisational music.

Mr. Chair independently released two acclaimed studio albums of original music, Nebulebula (2019) and Better Days (2023) in collaboration with trombonist Mark Hetzler and guitarist José Guzmán. In 2022, Mr. Chair produced Sirena with Guzmán, singer Leslie Damaso, violinist Janice Lee, and saxophonist Jon Irabagon. Mr. Chair's newest collaboration is Spectaculous, an orchestral hip hop album with singer and poet Dequadray White. The debut single from Spectaculous "Tempo" has garnered over 11,000 views on YouTube and +500,000 plays on Instagram and Spotify.

In December 2024, Mr. Chair launched a new project featuring their rendition of Vince Guaraldi's A Charlie Brown Christmas, selling out multiple venues in the greater Madison area. The holiday project evolves in 2025 with a concert at the iconic Ravinia Festival and an expanded performance at Madison's Orpheum Theatre featuring the string section of the Wisconsin Chamber Orchestra.

Mr. Chair's eclectic projects are united by a fearless exploration of musical storytelling, creative independence, technical precision and dynamic, energizing performances.

Jason Kutz

PIANO, MR. CHAIR

Jason Kutz is a musician based in Madison, WI, playing, performing, teaching, and composing all styles of music. He is rooted in contemporary music and improvisation, often combining acoustic and classical piano styles with

electronic synthesis. He studied recording technology and music business at UW-Oshkosh and completed his Master's in Piano Performance at UW-Madison.

In 2018 and 2019 Kutz was commissioned by Dr. Stephen Meyers, Vilas Distinguished Professor of Geoscience at UW–Madison, to write two pieces of science–inspired music. He was also commissioned by the Wisconsin Academy for Arts, Letters & Sciences in 2022. This work was inspired by Bruce Crownover's prints from *The Last Glacier*, and the final piece was a music video that accompanied an animation of Crownover's work entitled *Melody for a Melting Glacier*.

When not performing in Mr. Chair, he is drawn towards free improvisation. He founded the Wonderporium – an electronic, ambiance–making trio that features multi–instrumentalist Noah Gilfillan, tubist Tom Curry, and dozens of synthesizers and pedals. He also performs in a free improvisation duo with saxophonist Jon Irabagon, showcasing their mutual appreciation for music chaotic and beautiful.

You may also find him as orchestra member, graphic designer, or soloist with the Wisconsin Chamber Orchestra, Caroga Arts Collective, or in other classical/crossover music organizations.




Ben Ferris

BASS, MR. CHAIR

Ben Ferris is a bassist, composer, and educator from Madison, WI. Ben performs regularly in the midwest, especially with the Ben Ferris Trio, a creative music ensemble that focuses on new

compositions by musicians in the band.



Ben is a founding member of Mr Chair, a contemporary ensemble of electronic trombone (Mark Hetzler), keyboard (Jason Kutz), percussion (Mike Koszewski) and electronic upright bass. As a sideman Ben performs with Darren Sterud, Nuggernaut (jazz-funk), The Jon Hoel Trio (original compositions with saxophone led trio), Gabe Burdulis Band (Nashville based original pop/rock music), as well as a number of performances in the classical, jazz, rock and contemporary music scenes.

A student of NEA Jazz Master Richard Davis, he graduated with a music-education degree from UW-Madison. He recently completed a Masters Degree in String Performance with Peter Dominguez at UW-Madison where he is currently pursuing a DMA in String Performance. Ben is the project assistant for the Bridge Ensemble, a combined string quartet and jazz quartet that travels to do clinics and performances in public schools.

As an educator, Ben teaches a studio of bass students, and has taught K-12 general music, songwriting, strings and jazz ensembles in public schools for seven years. He is on the board of directors and faculty for the Richard Davis Foundation for Young Bassists.




Mike Koszewski

Mike Koszewski is an experienced musician from Madison, WI with a diverse background in the percussive arts. After graduating from the University of Wisconsin – Madison percussion studio, Mike

He is a member of the experimental jazz/rock combo Lovely Socialite and the Ben Ferris Octet, and is well-regarded as a session/freelance musician in Madison and beyond.
